



## MR. X CREATES MAYHEM FOR AMERICAN PSYCHO II

TORONTO, CANADA - September 28, 2001 -- Mr. X, Inc., which specializes in digital visual effects for feature films and music videos, is providing ten shots for American Psycho II: The Girl Who Wouldn't Die, the sequel to the 2000 cerebral slasher American Psycho. The Lions Gate distributed film is scheduled for release in the Spring of 2002.

The Mr. X team, led by President Dennis Berardi and Visual Effects Compositor Marco Polsinelli, are working to create a computer generated sequence in which a car that has been run off the road and into a ravine, burns and explodes. In addition the company is providing a number of continuity fixes.

Starring Mila Kunis (best know as Jackie, Kelso's ex-girlfriend on That 70s Show) the film is set nearly 15 years after the events of American Psycho. This is the story of a college freshman and Patrick Bateman survivor who becomes a teaching assistant even as she develops her own murderous obsessions, destroying anyone in her way.

At the same time, the company is also working on Hypercube, the sequel to the 1997 Canadian sleeper sci-fi hit Cube; collaborating with writer/director/producer Atom Egoyan on the feature Ararat, based on the Armenian Genocide of 1915-1923; and on Men With Brooms, actor/director Paul Gross' "sweeping epic" which revolves around four ex-members of a curling team who are reunited when they return to town to attend the funeral of their former coach.

Since the January 15th launch of Mr. X earlier this year, the company has completed the photo-realistic computer generated effects, compositing and online conform on music videos for Doyle Bramhall II and Smokestack's Green Light Girl (RCA Records) and Default's Wasting My Time (TVT Records); Digitally extended all the sets with CG built elements for Hallmark/TNT's Prince Charming, a made for television film directed by Allan Arkush, starring Martin Short, Christina Applegate, Bernadette Peters, and Billy Connolly; and completed digital effects compositing and on-set visual effects supervision for numerous sequences for the Victorious Films feature Century Hotel.
